Zoom Best Practices

SETTING EXPECTATIONS

It's important to set basic expectations for students from the beginning. Some helpful expectations include:

- Ask students to keep their camera on (but don't require)
- Set up zoom to mute students' mics upon entering, and manually mute students
 when they aren't contributing
- Ask students to use the "raise hand" function when they have a question
- Invite students to use the Zoom chat for quick questions
- Require a policy of not interrupting each other
- Record your Zoom meeting to post later
- Ask everyone to use gallery view instead of speaker view
- Enable "<u>change name</u>" function in Zoom settings, and encourage everyone to display their preferred name or nickname, and pronouns

INCREASING ENGAGEMENT

There are a lot of techniques to increase student engagement in online settings. A few tips include:

- Use icebreakers to start classes off, and online energizers in longer classes
- Use breakout rooms for small group discussions before engaging in whole class discussions
- Encourage <u>productive group work</u>, give specific instructions and tasks for breakout rooms
- Encourage the use of reactions, ask students to respond to quick questions in the chat, use polls
- <u>Use collaborative Google Docs</u> to encourage students to work together

PRACTICES FOR INCLUSIVITY

There are many ways you can encourage inclusivity in a virtual setting. A few practices include:

- Share your own preferred name and pronouns, <u>rename your Zoom name</u> with your pronouns, and encourage students to <u>rename themselves</u> with theirs (example: "Jane Doe, she/her")
- Ask students to volunteer to answer questions, instead of calling on them first. Be sure
 to choose different students to speak first.
- Learn how to pronounce all participants' preferred names
